







Adjustment Layers | Clipping Layer | TK Settings

New Document | Undo | Redo | Zoom In

Fit Image | Zoom to 100% | Zoom Out

Black Brush | White Brush | Color Brush | Gray Brush



Curves | Levels

Brightness/Contrast | Photo Filter

Hue/Saturation | Black & White

Selective Color | Vibrance

Color Balance | Exposure

Color Mixer | Invert


Gradient | Solid Color

Click once to create a layer showing clipped shadows in **blue** and highlights in **red**.

Click a second time to delete the layer

(suggest increasing to the right)

Fit | Zoom to 100%



Zoom IN

Zoom OUT



- Opens the brush tool with 50% gray foreground color
- Opens the brush tool along with the color picker tool
- Opens the brush tool with white foreground color
- Opens the brush tool with black foreground color

Blend Mode Buttons


Applies the selected blend mode to the active layer

NOTE: There are several other blend modes in Photoshop. These are the most commonly used.



Normal | Soft Light | Color | Screen

Luminosity | Overlay | Linear Light | Multiply



Duplicate Image

- Duplicates the current image
- NOT the same as duplicating a layer

Size

- Opens the Image Size panel
- Resize the image width and height
- Change resolution

Flatten

- Compresses all layers into one layer
- All previous layer work is lost

Canvas

- Opens the Canvas Size panel
- Resize the canvas (not the image) width and height



Click to add a new blank layer above the current layer

CMD/CTRL-click to add a new pixel blank layer at the top of the layer stack



Creates a new layer merged from all visible layers



Inverts the contents of a pixel layer or a mask



Non-smart object layers: Duplicates the layer

Smart object layers: Copies the layer using the New Smart Object via Copy command




Converts the current layer to a smart object layer (if allowed by Photoshop)



Places selected layers into group

Left side creates the group with a black conceal all mask
Right side creates the group with a white reveal all mask

Deletes selected layers




Dodge

- Left side creates a 50% gray layer with the brush tool set to white
- Right side creates a transparent layer with the brush tool set to white

Burn


- Left side creates a 50% gray layer with the brush tool set to black
- Right side creates a transparent layer with the brush tool set to black

Mask Buttons



**Remove/Add Layer Mask | Add Black Mask |
Add Clipping to Layer | Delete Invisible Layers**

**Apply User Saved Masks | Toggle Image/Mask |
Disable/Enable Mask**



If the current layer has a mask applied:


The mask is removed

If the current layer does not have a mask:


A White reveal all mask is applied

If there is a selection active:

A mask is applied based on the selection




Adds a black conceal all mask to the active layer




Toggles clipping and unclipping to the active layer


Layer clipping means the layer being clipped affects only the layer directly below it (used for adjustment layers).




Deletes all layers with their visibility turned OFF



Applies user saved masks (in the Channels panel) to the active layer



Toggles between the image view and the mask view



Toggles the mask in the active layer ON and OFF

Used to see the affect of a mask on a layer

Tools Buttons




Stroke | Fill | Blur


Free Transform | Adobe Camera Raw | Content Aware Fill



Opens the Stroke dialog window



Opens the Fill dialog window




Opens the Gaussian Blur dialog window



Initiates Free Transform mode



Opens the Adobe Camera Raw filter



Opens the Content Aware Fill window

Must have a selection active first

Selections Buttons



Select Subject | Select Sky | Deselect/Reselect Selection | Save Selection

Feather Selection | Expand Selection | Contract Selection | Invert Selection

Hide/Show Marching Ants | Select & Mask | Invert Selections



Invokes the Select Subject command

Invokes the Select Sky command



Deselects an active selection

Creates the last used selection



Saves an active selection to the Channels panel



Opens the Feathers Selection dialog
(only if there's an active selection)




Opens the Expand Selection dialog

Opens the Contract Selection dialog

(only if there's an active selection)




Inverts the active selection



Toggles the machine ants ON and OFF




Opens the Select & Mask panel



Deletes all alpha channels from the Channels panel


(use to delete user saved selections as masks in the Channels panel (alpha channels) to save file space)






Opens the TK Web Sharpening dialog




Opens the TK Watermarking dialog




